## Application Fees

A new Patient will pay an initial fee, speak to the doctor, then obtain a medical marijuana card from the state of Connecticut. Existing Patients will have an appointment with B & B up to a month prior to their medical marijuana card's expiration date.

## Scheduling Procedure

Patients must renew their card annually. Your medical card will always have the same month and day as the expiration date. Although you won't get in trouble for renewing your card late (other than not being a valid patient for a length of time), you will get less than a year's worth out of your card. To avoid that and to ensure that you get a full year out of your medical card, B & B will set up a yearly appointment with you.

**Ex:** Initial appointment was on: 08/10/20

Card expires on: 08/11/21

Next appointment between: 07/11/21-08/11/21

## Follow-up Appointments

B & B shall schedule patients with a follow up visit six (6) months after their initial or renewal appointment to maintain an ongoing relationship, and to monitor the effectiveness of medical marijuana for patients.
